



Raise awareness of CDV as the regional leader in the promotion of Venezuelan arts and culture

Measurable Objectives:

1. Develop and implement an ongoing marketing and communications plan, including a clear message, a media outreach campaign, and a membership recruitment strategy:

<u>PROGRESS UPDATE</u>: Created special alliance and partnership with media outlets, organizations and corporations in the region – ongoing.

1. Participate in at least two high profile community events per year.

<u>PROGRESS UPDATE:</u> Penn's Landing Hispanic Fiesta, MAC Global Fusion.



Strategic Plan 2007-2009 Goal #2 & Measurable Objectives

Develop at least three permanent, ongoing cultural programs in Venezuelan art, language, and music

Measurable Objectives:

1. Offer at least one cultural program in Venezuelan art, language, and music on a quarterly basis every year.

2. Present programs throughout the Delaware Valley region wherever large groups of constituents are located.

Strategic Plan 2007-2009 Goal #3 & Measurable Objectives

Strengthen and diversify CDV's fundraising efforts

Measurable Objectives:

- 1. Create and implement a comprehensive resource development (fundraising) plan with assistance from a nonprofit fundraising professional.
- 2. Provide fundraising training to the Board of Directors.
- 3. Introduce at least one new revenue source every year.
- 4. Increase the organization's revenue stream by at least 5% every year.

<u>PROGRESS UPDATE:</u> in progress, expecting to start in Summer 2008 by hiring the consulting services on Fundraising Development of The nonprofit Center of La Salle University.



Strategic Plan 2007-2009 Goal #4 & Measurable Objectives

Establish and office for Casa de Venezuela in Philadelphia

Measurable Objectives:

- 1. Acquire an office location and mailing address in Philadelphia through a minimal expenditure of revenue.
- 2. Develop and pursue a strategy to create a permanent home for Casa de Venezuela by 2009.

<u>PROGRESS UPDATE:</u> scheduling meeting with City of Philadelphia officials, researching potential partnership with organizations in the region, checking funding sources needed to purchase or repair a potential property.



Strategic Plan 2007-2009 Goal #5 & Measurable Objectives

Strengthen CDV's governance and management system

Measurable Objectives:

- 1. Revise bylaws to reflect best practices in nonprofit governance.
- 2. Develop a policy and procedures manual for the Board of Directors, Committees, volunteers, and members.
- 3. Engage in ongoing Board development activities to improve Board member recruitment, orientation, training, and succession.

<u>PROGRESS UPDATE</u>: Grant from Hispanic in Philanthropy received for "Board Development" with consultant Jason Alexander from The Nonprofit Center of La Salle University. Bylaws will be reviewed, and policy and procedure manuals will be developed. Number of Board members, roles & responsibilities, recruitment, training and succession planning will be reviewed. Project started in June 2008 and is expected to be completed in 2 months.



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Strategic Plan 2007-2009 Goal #6 & Measurable Objectives

Explore ways to improve CDV's membership programs

Measurable Objectives:

- 1. Authorize a Board member or volunteer to research and develop a set of recommendations for improving, enhancing, and/or restructuring Casa de Venezuela's membership program.
- 2. If approved by the Board of Directors, implement recommendations in a timely and efficient manner.

<u>PROGRESS UPDATE</u>: Grant from HIP includes funding for the acquisition of software for managing membership information and communication.


